

- 13 1km after the village turn left, signposted Brackenside/Woodend/Woodside.
- 14 Road passes the entrance to Woodside, Cold Harbour and Brackenside.
- 15 At T-junction turn right on B6353 towards Ford (no signpost).
- 16 Continue downhill and turn right into Ford Village.

The Hilly Countryside Cycle Tour



Cycling Route No. 2 via Fenton & Woodside

Distance: 21 miles (33 km)

Grade: Good ride on country lanes



- 1 Leave Ford Village and turn right cycling down the hill.
- 2 Turn left at Ford Church signposted Kimmerston (Cycle Route 68).
- 3 In 2km after passing riding stables, at T-junction, turn right (sign to Milfield is hidden).
- 4 In 1.5km turn left, signposted Doddington/Fenton.
- 5 In 2km fork left, signposted Fenton Hill/Kimmerston.
- 6 In 2km at T-junction, turn right (no signpost).
- 7 In 4km at crossroads, cross over B6525 (by white bungalow).
- 8 In 1.5km at T-junction, turn left (no signpost).
- 9 In 1km at crossroads in Lowick by The White Swan & Village Store, cross over (no signpost).
- 10 In 2km at T-junction, turn left (no signpost).
- 11 In 1km at T-junction, turn right onto B6525 (no signpost).
- 12 In 500m turn left, signposted Bowsden/Duddo. Pass through Bowsden Village.
