- In 500m take 2nd left into Crookham village (B6353).
- 13 In 2km turn left (signed no through road) to return to Heatherslaw Mill.


Cycling Route No. 4 via Branxton & Crookham

Distance: 10 miles (16 km)

Grade: Medium with steep hills



- Leave Heatherslaw travelling uphill (Heatherslaw Corn Mill on vour left).
- At T-junction turn left (no sign).
- In 600m turn right at T-junction, signposted Milfield/Wooler.
- In 1km turn right at the T-junction, onto A697 signposted Coldstream. (Please take EXTRA care on this section).
- In 400m turn left (no sign post).
- Steady uphill climb for 1km passing Blinkbonny Farm.
- 1 In a further 1km you will pass the first signpost to Branxton, do not turn right here, but continue along past Branxton Moor Farm, then turn right in 500m (signposted East Learmouth/Cornhill).
- 8 In 1.5km turn right, signposted Branxton/Crookham.
- In 1.5km pass Flodden Field, continue to Branxton village.
- 10 At T-junction turn right, signposted Wooler/Ford/ Crookham.
- In 2km, turn right at T-junction onto A697, signposted Crookham/ Milfield. (Please take EXTRA care at this junction).




