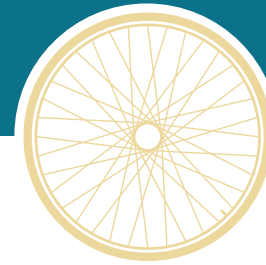


Rivers & Countryside Cycle Tour



Cycling Route No. 5

via Till Valley and Woodend

Distance: 10½ miles (20 km)

Grade: Country lanes with hills



- 13 At T-junction, turn right onto B6353 towards Ford (no signpost).
- 14 Continue downhill through Ford Village passing Ford Church on right.
- 15 Turn left over Ford Bridge, signposted Coldstream A697.
- 16 In 600m turn right signposted Crookham/Cornhill.
- 17 In 600m turn right (signed no through road) to return to Heatherslaw Corn Mill. There are shops, a café and toilets located here.

- 1 Leave Heatherslaw over iron bridge, turn left past car park, through gate on to Cycle Route 68.
- 2 Continue to Etal Village and turn left into the village street.
- 3 Cycle past the castle and downhill to the river. Turn right (route 68).
- 4 Continue along the river for approximately 2km.
- 5 Continue on cycle path until zig-zag path up from the river past Tindal House Farm. Turn right onto farm road at end of path.
- 6 At T-junction, turn left (route 68).
- 7 In 600m, turn right at crossroads.
- 8 In 1km, at T-junction, fork left onto B6354 signposted Berwick.
- 9 In 600m, turn right (no signpost) past Mattilees Cottage.
- 10 In 1km, at bottom of hill, fork right signposted Gatherick/Woodend.
- 11 In 1km, at crossroads, go straight ahead signposted Woodside/Woodend.
- 12 Sharp left bend at Woodend Farm. In 1km turn right at the T-junction.
