- Cycle through Tweedhill, with sandstone wall on your left.
- Cross Union Bridge over River Tweed and return to England.
- 16 In 800m, at T-junction, turn right signposted Horncliffe.
- In 1.5km, at T-junction, turn left and almost immediately at T-junction turn right onto A698 (both unsigned).
- In 300m, turn left off A698, signposted Thornton/ Shoreswood.
- 19 In 500m, fork right (unsigned). In 1km, at T-junction, turn left signposted West Allerdean/ Ancroft.
- 20 Almost immediately turn right signposted Felkington/Duddo.
- In 2km at T-Junction turn left signposted Berwick/Etal/Duddo.
- 22 At T-Junction turn right, signposted Wooler/Etal/Duddo. In Duddo fork right, signposted Coldstream/Tiptoe/Shellacres.
- At crossroads turn left onto Route 68 (signposted Etal/Ford).
- Follow Route 68 back to Tindal House, Etal and Heatherslaw.

- Leave Heatherslaw over the iron bridge, turn left on Cycle Route 68.
- Continue to Etal Village and turn left into the village street.
- 3 Cycle past the castle and downhill to the river. Turn right (route 68).
- Continue along the river for approximately 2km.
- Cycle path climbs steeply in a zigzag away from the river and past Tindal House Farm. Turn right and follow road, around right bend, along an avenue of trees.
- At T-junction, turn left (route 68).
- Cycle past houses in wood on right, following signs for Norham.
- 8 At T-junction, turn left onto A698 and immediately right (Route 68).
- At T-junction turn left (Route 68) Enter Norham village and bear left.
- Cross the bridge into Scotland (Tweed Cycleway and Route 1).
- Turn right signposted Ladykirk.
- After Horndean, turn right at T-junction, signposted Berwick B6461.
- In 2.5km, fork right signposted Horncliffe/Tweedhill (2t weight limit sign).
