Car Parking

Parking for this event is located at Etal Showground. Please respect the community and park here.

There is a parking charge of **£2** to help support the cost of running this event.

Do not attempt to park within the villages or on grass verges. Thank you for your cooperation and helping to make this a safe and enjoyable event for everyone.



Disabled Parking

Etal: Etal Village Hall car park is reserved exclusively for disabled visitors.

Ford: please use the reserved bays opposite Ford Village Shop.

Heatherslaw: there is disabled parking behind the Visitor Centre. This is accessed via the B6353 between Crookham village and Ford Bridge. The turning is signed for disabled parking (follow this narrow road to the end).

Getting Around

Vintage Double Decker Buses run in a loop between Etal, Heatherslaw and Ford. A single ticket is £3, or you can travel as many times as you like for £5. Children travel free. Buy tickets with cash or card at the information points in Ford, Etal and Heatherslaw. *NB: You cannot pay on the bus.*

Heatherslaw Light Railway runs between Heatherslaw and Etal, the train journey takes 20 minutes. Diesel trains will be running on the hour from Heatherslaw and from the half hour at Etal. The first train is at 11:00 from Heatherslaw, the last train is at 14:30 from Etal. Tickets cost £5 return for adults and £3 for children and can be purchased at Heatherslaw Ticket Office or on Etal station when the train arrives.
