## The Christmas Tree Trail

Follow the trail of Christmas Trees, guess the Country that inspired the decoration for each tree and drop off your answers to enter the prize draw to win either an adult hamper, or a child hamper (both hampers on display in Heatherslaw Corn Mill Gift Shop).

Trail maps cost £1 and can be picked up from information points in Etal, Ford and Heatherslaw. Leave your completed trail maps at any of these locations to be entered into the prize draw. The winners will be announced on Ford and Etal's social media within a few days of the event.

## Free Car Parking

Free parking for this event is located at Etal Showground. Please respect the community and park here. Do not attempt to park within the villages or on grass verges. Thank you for your cooperation and helping to make this a safe and enjoyable event for everyone.

## Disabled Parking

Parking spaces are limited and it is a case of first come, first served.

**Etal:** Etal Village Hall car park is reserved exclusively for disabled visitors.

**Ford:** please use the reserved bays opposite Ford Village Shop and at Ford Castle.

**Heatherslaw:** there is disabled parking in the small car park next to Heatherslaw Light Railway.

## Getting Around

### Vintage Double Decker Buses

These run in a loop between Etal, Heatherslaw and Ford. A single ticket is £4, or you can travel as many times as you like for £5. Children travel free.

Buy tickets with cash or card at the information points in Ford, Etal and Heatherslaw or online at [www.ford-etal-christmas-market.sumupstore.com](http://www.ford-etal-christmas-market.sumupstore.com). Tickets can then be collected from the information points with proof of purchase.

**NB:** You cannot pay on the bus.

## Heatherslaw Light Railway

Diesel trains run between Heatherslaw and Etal, the journey takes 20 minutes and trains run every 70 minutes. The first train is at 11:05 from Heatherslaw and 11:40 from Etal, the last train is at 14:35 from Heatherslaw and 15:10 from Etal. Return tickets cost £5 for adults and £3 for children and can be purchased at Heatherslaw Ticket Office or at Etal station when the train arrives.

Christmas Special steam trains are also running this weekend, some tickets may still be available, please visit [www.heatherslawlightrailway.co.uk](http://www.heatherslawlightrailway.co.uk) for details and bookings. Adult and children's tickets are £20, under 2s travel free, with all children receiving a gift from Santa.

## Footpaths Between the Villages

These are waymarked walks between Etal and Heatherslaw (approx. 15 minutes) and Heatherslaw and Ford (approx. 40 minutes, good footwear is advised for this section which can get muddy in places). Maps are available from information points.
